2. DECLARATION OF COUNCILLOR'S INTERESTS RELEVANT TO MATTERS ARISING ON THE AGENDA

3. PLANNING: DA/2010/0058 EXTENSION TO SCRUTINEERING BUILDING AT WHILTON MILL.

The plans were reviewed together with the relevant Mill history. It was resolved to object to the application on the following grounds: the increased capacity could lead to more races per event with the resultant increase in noise and pollution; the mechanics viewing platform, being visible from the road, could be a distraction to motorists on the C5 red route.
